Rotary International is a global network of 1.4 million friends and leaders, who see a world where people unite and take action to create lasting change – in our communities and across the globe. For more than 110 years, Members from 46,000+ clubs use their passion and energy to take action on sustainable projects. From literacy and peace to water and health, we are always committed and working to better our world.

Having received our charter on June 9, 1926, our club will soon be celebrating 100 years of service! We are a fellowship service organization made up of business and community-minded individuals with high ethical standards. Our mission is to provide service to our community, fellowship with members, and personal and professional development. We truly have an excellent record of service – living by Rotary International's Motto of "Service Above Self". Here are some of the projects in which we are involved in our community:

- We award scholarships to as well as organize judging competitions/mentorship programs for IRSC students

- We partnered with Publix & IRC Schools, supplying every school with dedicated plastic bag receptacles
